

Rules and Conditions

1. Rules & Penalties will be on display on the day of the event. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are complying with the rules of the competition.
2. No horse or pony to compete more than once in any one class and in no more than two classes (excluding pairs). IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ABIDE BY THIS RULE.
3. There will be a timed section for all classes
4. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary
5. Competitors failing to obey instruction given by Fence Judges, Stewards, Judges or other officials will be disqualified.
6. Hard Hats must be worn at all times when mounted: EN1384 (1966), PAS015 (1988), BS EN1384 (1977) (with BSI Kite Mark) or Snell E2001, or AS/NZS 3838/1988 or AS/NZS 3838/2003 (with SAI Global).
7. Smart Dress code is compulsory, either cross country or show jumping attire, with proper riding boots and jodhpurs.
8. Body protectors are compulsory for juniors and recommended for seniors.
9. The Judges decision is final. Any objections must be handed in, in writing, with a deposit of £25 within 10 minutes of the results being published. The deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.
10. No farrier on call – Please ensure that your Horse/Pony is well shod.
11. Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times. Young children must be supervised at all times.
12. Horses and Ponies must not be left unattended in the lorry park unless secured correctly inside the trailer/horse box.
13. Please respect the hospitality of the land owners and take your litter home. Do not clean out your trailer/horses box in the field.

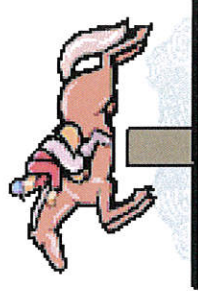

Class 1: Minimus – Lead Rein

Entry: £8 (pre entry)

Fences not to exceed 1ft 6", many will be smaller. Riders must be able to control ponies adequately to be jumping in this class. Lead reins must not be attached to bits. (This course will be located in the main show field)

PRIZES: Trophy for 1st place. Rosettes 1st - 6th

Class 2: Minimus

Entry: £8 (pre entry)

Fences not to exceed 1ft 6" many smaller. (same course as class 1)

PRIZES: Trophy for 1st place. Rosettes 1st - 6th

Class 3 Novice Pairs (2ft - 2ft3)

Entry: £12 per pair (pre entry)

Fences not to exceed 2ft 3"

PRIZES: Trophy for 1st place. Rosettes 1st - 6th

Class 4: Open Novice (2ft - 2ft3)

Entry: £12 (pre entry)

Fences not to exceed 2ft 3"

Class will be split into Juniors & Seniors if entries permit.

Juniors not to have attained their 16th birthday on 1st January 2014.

PRIZES: Trophy for 1st place. Rosettes 1st - 6th

Class 5: Intermediate Pairs (2ft3 - 2ft6)

Entry: £12 per pair (pre entry)

Fences not to exceed 2ft 6"

PRIZES: Trophy for 1st place. Rosettes 1st - 6th

Class 6 Open (2ft6 – 2ft9)

Entry: £8 (pre entry)

Fences not to exceed 2ft 9"ft.

Class will be split into Juniors & Seniors if entries permit.

Juniors not to have attained their 16th birthday on 1st January 2014.

PRIZES: Trophy for 1st place. Rosettes 1st - 6th
