- 2. No horse or pony to compete more than once in any one class.
- 3. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary
- 4. Competitors failing to obey instruction given by Fence Judges, Stewards, Judges or other officials will be disqualified.
- 5. Hard Harts must be worn at all times when mounted: EN1384 (1966), PAS015 (1988), BS EN1384 (1977) (with BSI Kite Mark) or Snell E2001, or AS/NZS 3838/1988 or AS/nzs 3838/2003 (with SAI Global).
- 6. Smart Dress code is compulsory, with proper riding boots and jodphurs.
- 7. Body protectors recommended for juniors.
- 8. The Judges decision is final. Any objections must be handed in, in writing, with a deposit of £25 within 10 minutes of the results being published. The deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.
- 9. No farrier on call Please ensure that your Horse/Pony is well shod.
- 10. Dogs must be kept of a short lead at all times. Young children must be supervised at all times.
- 11. Horses and Ponies must not be left unattended in the lorry park unless secured correctly inside the trailer/horse box.
- 12. Please respect the hospitality of the land owners and take your litter home. Do not clean out your trailer/horses box in the field.
