NEW RULES—We would like to highlight some new BRC rules for 2020. While these rules will not necessarily apply to our Club shows this year they will be more widely rolled out at many other events. In particular, Flu Vaccination rules often depend on the venue, so we do advise members to be familiar with them. Flu Vaccination — some activities/venues now require a booster to have been administered 'within' 6 months of the date of event. Whip rule — new padded whips are becoming required. Microchips—from later this year these will be compulsory in England, and will a requirement at BRC/other events held there.
