Annual General Meeting

Unfortunately, as you were all aware we had to cancel our annual general meeting, that was due to be held at the end of March 2020, due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

We had hoped to re-arrange this AGM during the summer or autumn, but that was not to be as the restrictions continued. Our next option was to go virtual, but as we are now into December, we felt that time was against us to set this up with Christmas around the corner.

Therefore, the committee is proposing three actions:

- 1) This newsletter detailing the committee's proposals, but giving you the opportunity to make alternative proposals, and make nominations followed by
- 2) Publication on web site of financial statements, Last AGM Minutes and proposals (by end of December) followed by:
- 2) A proxy vote, by post, or e-mail which will be sent at the end of December but with a deadline to vote by 21st January 2021. This will cover the proposals, the financial statements and previous AGM minutes, which will be available to view online after Christmas.

All current 2020 members or parents/guardians of junior members are entitled to vote at AGM. However, if you are a 2019 member we will take into consideration any alternative proposals that you wish to suggest.

AGM—Proposals to be voted on by proxy vote:

As you are aware we always strive to keep participation costs down. Therefore it is with regret that we need to put forward some increase in fees for 2021 (note this is the same as was proposed for 2020 in March 2020 newsletter):

1) MEMBERSHIPS— This is due to the BRC (British Riding Clubs) fees being increased yet again, so for <u>every member</u> we now have to give the BRC £16.00 (his went up again this year. There was also an additional 30% increase in the Club insurance. We have held our fees down for a number of years, but we are sure you can see this is no longer sustainable. Therefore our proposal is:

Membership <u>both</u> Junior & Senior to be £25.00 (£20.00 if before 1st June)

2) ENTRY FEES: Entry fees for Members-only shows: Show Jumping/Showing (from £2.50) to £3.00, Games/Clear Round (from £1.50) to £2.00 (Note: this excludes special events such as jump X and open shows/events)





3) COMMITTEE - Every 3 years, members of the Committee stand down by rotation but can be re-elected.

NEW RULES—We would like to highlight some new BRC rules for 2020. While these rules will not necessarily apply to our Club shows this year they will be more widely rolled out at many other events. In particular, Flu Vaccination rules often depend on the venue, so we do advise members to be familiar with them. Flu Vaccination — some activities/venues now require a booster to have been administered 'within' 6 months of the date of event. Whip rule — new padded whips are becoming required for BSJA and some other events. Microchips—from 12th February 2021 these will be compulsory in Wales following England where these became compulsory last year and will be a requirement at BRC/other events held over the border.
