WARMUP/ NON-QUALIFIER ENTRIES

- Class 1: 9am start,
- Entries close **4th June 2026 for non-qualifier classes**

When returning your Entry form, please include special requests in the email. We will try to accommodate reasonable requests but cannot guarantee this.

Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook. Eligibility will be taken from the date of the qualifier, any points/gained between the qualifier and championships will not be counted. All competitors must be a member and be on the BRC Database by midday the Friday before the qualifier. All riders must have a competition pass on their membership profile for the horse they are riding. Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.

This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the close of entry from the original date the qualifier is scheduled for.

BRC have adjusted the numbers to qualify due to requests from many areas. For further information on the numbers to qualify for BRC championships, members are advised to review the BRC current handbook

Hats

All hats must have a visible HOT PINK BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground, to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up-to-date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Body Protectors

Body protectors are not required for combined training, however riders may wear them at their discretion; if worn, body protectors should be up to standard.

Flu Vaccinations

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations following rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also an excel date checker spreadsheet available to download on the BRC website. It is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.

Rules & Conditions

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules as in the BRC Handbook 2026 and its subsequent amendments. <https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook/>.

- It is the team managers' and competitors' responsibility to ensure they and their horses are eligible for these classes and are aware of all relevant rules regarding the competition, tack and turnout etc. A tack inspection will be carried out prior to competing in any class.
- **Juniors:** It is the Team Manager's responsibility to gain parental consent for juniors to enter this event.
- **Hats: All hats must meet the BRC current standard and have a visible (Pink) hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground.** There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.
- **Non-Qualifier Entries - Non-BRC members must ensure they have their own insurance.**
- **Flu Vaccinations:** Your horse's influenza vaccination record must be up to date in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. This record must be checked for all the qualifier classes prior to competing.
- **Numbers:** All riders competing in the qualifier classes must bring their own bridle or saddle pad numbers.
- **Lorry & vehicle parking:** All drivers must adhere to instructions from the Parking Stewards when given. Lorries and Trailers must park with consideration for others and should be at least 5m apart. Horses or ponies tied to a vehicle/trailer must not be left unattended or left in trailers that have been detached from the towing vehicle. No skipping out of lorries/trailers.
- Riders and spectators at all events should always behave appropriately. No riders or spectators shall behave in an offensive, abusive or unpleasant manner to any person.
- Children under 16 must be under adult supervision at all times.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and dog muck must be picked up.
- All attending must have regard and consideration for others' property and ensure that all rubbish is deposited in bins provided or removed from the area to a suitable place or taken back home for disposal.
- Official photographs will be taken at this event and may be published on websites, social media or in other publications. If you do not want your photograph to be used, please make the Secretary of the event aware of this.

Organisation

- **Late entries:** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £5 per individual or pair and £10 per team if space permits.
Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore should not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.

- Entry fees will not be refunded unless the event is abandoned.
- **Event abandonment:** Should the event be abandoned due to weather or any other circumstances, LMRC reserve the right to retain 25% of entry fees to cover non-refundable costs.
- The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, or add sections to, classes or alter the running order depending on entries. They cannot be held responsible for any errors or inaccuracies in the schedule.
- The Judge's decision is final. Any complaint must be made to the Organiser or Official Steward within 30 mins of the incident, or the result being published. They will be handled as per the BRC Handbook, G14.1
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any class.
- The Organisers reserve the right to ask anybody to leave the show ground.

Health, Safety & Welfare

- The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Official Stewards.
- If attending the Show on your own, you **MUST** leave an emergency contact name and telephone number with your Team Manager or the Show Secretary when you arrive.
- Any competitor who has had a fall in a warm-up area, competition arena or anywhere on site must see the advanced medic before remounting to start the competition/phase and follow their instructions.
- Neither LMRC, BRC Area 15, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landowner or his/her tenant, will hold themselves responsible for any accident to persons, property and/or horses. By entering this competition, competitors accept the risks involved in horse riding and competing.
- Non-members are not covered by the BRC insurance policy. It is mandatory for anyone attending this event to have third party liability insurance.

- **(c) Riders not to have completed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years**
- **Horses may only compete at two consecutive heights, or twice at the same height, provided they are different tests.**
- **Horse and rider combinations may compete in more than one team in the same class (i.e 2 teams in the Novice CT).**
- **No horse or rider may compete twice in the same team.**
